#### **Timely-Filing Requirements**

Employers of Record (EOR's) have an important role in ensuring Mi Via employees and vendors are paid for services provided. It is important that EOR's approve employee timesheets, mileage reimbursement requests, and Vendor Payment Request forms (VPR's) on time

All billing including employee timesheets, mileage reimbursement requests, and VPR's:

- Must be submitted and approved every other week for employees and every week for VPRs
- If an EOR/participant cannot submit a VPRs on time, they have 90 days from the date of when the service was done to submit the VPR to Conduent
- Timesheets and VPRs submitted after 90 days from when service was done will not be approved because they were not submitted on time.
- If there is missing information or the VPR needs to be corrected, a Return-to Participant (RTP) notice will be issued via email. Please make sure that you have the correct email address in FOCoS. Please make sure to look for these emails and answer them right away. This helps make sure your vendors will be paid on time.

# Pre-signed Vendor Payment Request (VPR)

Pre-signing a VPR is not allowed in the Mi Via Waiver. Employer of Record (EOR)/participant cannot sign for a service <u>until after</u> the service has been provided. The signature is the EOR/participant saying the service was provided. If you have been asked to pre-sign a VPR or timesheet before the service has been provided, please contact a MAD Mi Via staff member listed under the Circle of Support or contact the Office of inspector General at:

#### W2 Tax Information for 2023

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires that all 2023 W-2s be mailed to employees no later than January 31, 2024. Palco will mail all W-2s through the United States Postal Service. If you do not receive your W-2 by February 15,2024, please contact the Consolidated Customer Service Center (CCSC) at 1-800-283-4465.

#### **Service Highlight**

## Environmental Modifications Service (EMOD)

EMOD services include the purchase and installation of equipment or making physical adaptations to the eligible participants residence that are necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the participant or improve the participants level of independence. EMOD services do not cover modifications or adaptations that would be considered normal upkeep of a residence.

The provider of the EMOD services must:

- Ensure correct design standards are addressed when planning and designing the adaptation or remodel.
- Must be a licensed and insured contractor or
- Must be an approved vendor that provides construction or remodeling services.

These services are available for a maximum of \$5000 every 5 years. An eligible participant moving into the Mi Via program from another waiver will carry their EMOD history for the previous five years of Home and Community Based Services (HCBS).

Some examples of environmental adaptations include the following:

- Installation of ramps and grab bars.
- Widening of doorways and hallways.
- Installation of automatic door openers and doorbells, etc.

EMOD services do not cover home improvements that would be considered normal

upkeep of a residences such as but not limited to:

- Rain gutters
- Tile replacement
- Mold repair
- Sagging floors
- New faucets
